AN ACT relating to governmental financial administration; making appropriations for various purposes relating to health, education and employment and other community services; revising provisions relating to the titles and maximum salaries of the unclassified personnel of the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada the sum of \$2,000,000
- 3 for the purpose of purchasing food for distribution to persons served
- 4 by the Food Bank.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 6 Fund to Three Square the sum of \$2,000,000 for the purpose of
- 7 purchasing food for distribution to persons served by Three Square
- 8 Food Bank.
- 9 **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 10 Fund to the Advisory Committee on Problem Gambling created by
- 11 NRS 458A.060 the sum of \$500,000 to conduct statewide seminars
- 12 on problem gambling awareness.



1 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Nevada the sum of
3 \$250,000 for its programs.

4 **Sec. 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
5 Fund to Boys Town Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for its programs.

6 **Sec. 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
7 Fund to Candlelighters Childhood Cancer Foundation of Nevada the
8 sum of \$1,000,000 for the provision of assistance to children
9 affected by cancer and their families.

10 **Sec. 7.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
11 Fund to Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada the sum of
12 \$3,000,000 for its Meals on Wheels Program.

13 **Sec. 8.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
14 Fund to the Cleveland Clinic Nevada the sum of \$3,000,000 for
15 medical services and research.

16 **Sec. 9.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
17 Fund to Communities in Schools of Nevada the sum of \$1,000,000
18 for its programs.

31 of the Department of Administration the sum of \$500,000 for books
32 and other research materials.

33 **Sec. 14.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
34 Fund to the Domestic Violence Resource Center in Reno, Nevada
35 the sum of \$1,000,000 for its programs and services.

36 **Sec. 15.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
37 Fund to Friends of Gem Theater the sum of \$1,000,000 for the
38 restoration of the Gem Theater in Pioche, Nevada.

39 **Sec. 16.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
40 Fund to the Gay and Lesbian Community Center of Southern
41 Nevada, Inc. the sum of \$1,000,000 for its programs and services.

42 **Sec. 17.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
43 Fund to Green Our Planet the sum of \$3,000,000 for its programs

3 Nevada, Las Vegas, the sum of \$500,000 for the “Expanding the

6 **Sec. 19.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
7 Fund to the Leadership Institute of Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for
8 educational training, support and programming for first-generation
9 college students.

10 **Sec. 20.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
11 Fund to the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada the sum of
12 \$4,000,000 for a capital improvement project.

13 **Sec. 21.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
14 Fund to the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada the sum of
15 \$250,000 for programs and services relating to tenants’ rights.

16 **Sec. 22.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
17 Fund to The Neon Museum the sum of \$1,000,000 for a capital
18 improvement project.

19 **Sec. 23.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
20 Fund to the Nevada Arts Council created by NRS 233C.025 the sum
21 of \$500,000 for its programs and activities.

22 **Sec. 24.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
23 Fund to the Nevada Blind Children’s Foundation the sum of
24 \$1,000,000 for its programs and services.

25 **Sec. 25.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
26 Fund to the Nevada Clean Energy Fund formed pursuant to NRS
27 701B.985 the sum of \$1,000,000 to use for obtaining federal money
28 to assist with carrying out qualified clean energy projects and
29 economic policies pursuant to NRS 701B.930 to 701B.995,
30 inclusive.

31 **Sec. 26.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
32 Fund to the Pioneer Center for the Performing Arts the sum of
33 \$1,000,000 for a capital improvement project.

34 **Sec. 27.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
35 Fund to the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern
36 Nevada the sum of \$5,000,000 for activities to stabilize transit
37 operations.

38 **Sec. 28.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
39 Fund to the Roseman University of Health Sciences the sum of
40 \$1,000,000 for recruitment of students.

41 **Sec. 29.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
42 Fund to Special Olympics Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for its
43 programs.



1 **Sec. 30.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Tahoe-Douglas Visitors Authority the sum of
3 \$1,200,000 for providing microtransit service.

4 **Sec. 31.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
5 Fund to United Way of Northern Nevada and the Sierra the sum of
6 \$1,200,000 for its United Readers Program.

7 **Sec. 32.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
8 Fund to the Greenspun College of Urban Affairs of the University of
9 Nevada, Las Vegas the sum of \$1,000,000 for tourist safety
10 initiatives.

11 **Sec. 33.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
12 Fund to Vegas PBS the sum of \$4,000,000 for digital educational
13 materials and activities related to the Outdoor Nevada television
14 program.

15 **Sec. 34.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
16 Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of \$2,500,000 for
17 allocation to the nonprofit corporation formed to establish an art
18 museum in Las Vegas, Nevada, upon a showing to the Committee:

19 1. That the corporation has been incorporated under the laws of
20 this State as a nonprofit corporation; and

21 2. That the purpose of the corporation is to establish an art
22 museum in Las Vegas, Nevada.

23 **Sec. 35.** Except for a state agency, as defined in NRS 223.470,
24 upon acceptance of the money appropriated by this act, the entity
25 that accepts the money agrees to:

26 1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
27 Committee on or before December 20, 2024, that describes each
28 expenditure made from the money appropriated by this act from the
29 date on which the money was received by the entity through
30 December 1, 2024;

31 2. Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
32 Committee on or before September 19, 2025, that describes each
33 expenditure made from the money appropriated by this act from the
34 date on which the money was received by the entity through
35 June 30, 2025; and

36 3. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
37 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
38 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
39 otherwise, of the entity, regardless of their form or location, that the
40 Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use
41 of the money appropriated by this act.

42 **Sec. 36.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
43 sections 1 to 34, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for
44 expenditure after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the
45 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the



1 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and
2 any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent
3 for any purpose after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to
4 which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money
5 was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the
6 State General Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

7 **Sec. 37.** Section 1 of Assembly Bill No. 522 of this session is
8 hereby amended to read as follows:

9 Section 1. The following state officers, employees and
10 medical and related positions are entitled to receive
11 approximate annual salaries of not more than the maximum
12 amounts set forth following their specified titles or positions:
