SUMMARY—Clarifies provisions governing the prescribing, dispensing and administering of drugs. (BDR 54-676)

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets *fomitted material* is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the healing arts; clarifying that certain providers of health care are authorized to prescribe, dispense or administer a drug for a purpose that has not been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law prohibits various providers of health care from knowingly procuring or administering a controlled substance or dangerous drug that is not approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration except in certain limited circumstances. (NRS 630.306, 631.3475, 632.347, 633.511, 635.130, 636.295) If the drug has been approved by the Food and Drug Administration for any purpose and certain other conditions are met, this bill clarifies that such persons and certain other professionals are authorized to prescribe, dispense or administer drug for a purpose that has not been approved by the Food and Drug Administration.
