SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the formation of a township in certain counties. (BDR 20-1110)

AN ACT relating to townships; revising provisions relating to the formation of a township in certain counties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, the board of county commissioners of each county may divide the county into a number of townships, but each township may not contain more than one incorporated city. (NRS 257.010) This bill allows the board of county commissioners of a county whose population is 30,000 or more but less than 40,000 (currently Lyon and Nye Counties) to include more than one incorporated city within a single township.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 257.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:
257.010 1. Subject to the limitations contained in subsection 2, the board of county commissioners of each county shall, from time to time, as the public good may require:
(a) Divide the county into a convenient number of townships; and
(b) Cause a description of such division to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the county within 10 days after adoption.

1 2. **[Not] Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, not**
2 more than one incorporated city in any county shall be included
3 within the same township. When any real property lying in one
4 established township is annexed pursuant to law by an incorporated
5 city lying within an adjacent established township, the boundaries of
6 the township in which the annexing incorporated city lies shall be
7 deemed to be extended to include the real property so annexed
8 without further action of the board of county commissioners.

9 3. **The board of county commissioners of a county whose**
10 **population is 30,000 or more but less than 40,000 may include**
11 **more than one incorporated city within the same township if the**
12 **board of county commissioners determines that it is in the best**
13 **interests of the county to do so.**
