
SENATE BILL NO. 403—SENATORS MANENDO AND FORD

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to effect increases in salaries for positions for sworn officers of the Nevada Highway Patrol. (BDR S-879)

AN ACT making appropriations from the State Highway Fund and the State General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of increasing by one grade the salaries for all positions for sworn officers of the Nevada Highway Patrol; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill makes appropriations from the State Highway Fund and the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of increasing by
3 one grade the salaries for all positions for sworn officers of the Nevada Highway
4 Patrol.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. To effect increases of one grade for the salaries
2 of all sworn officers of the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the
3 Department of Public Safety, there is hereby appropriated to the
4 State Board of Examiners from the State Highway Fund:
5 (a) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending on
6 June 30, 2018, the sum of \$1,991,381; and
7 (b) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending on
8 June 30, 2019, the sum of \$2,060,246
9 2. The State Board of Examiners, upon the recommendation of
10 the Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor,

1 may allocate and disburse to the Department of Public Safety out of
2 the money appropriated by this section, such sums of money as may
3 from time to time be required to pay for the increase of one grade
4 each for the salaries of all positions for sworn officers of the Nevada
5 Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety. The
6 sums appropriated by this section may not be allocated and
7 disbursed to address a deficiency between the appropriated money
8 as fixed by the 79th Session of the Nevada Legislature and the
9 requirements for salaries resulting from any circumstance other than
10 the increases in salaries described in this section.

11 3. Any remaining balance of an appropriation made by this act
12 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2019, by the
13 entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which
14 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in
15 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining
16 must not be spent for any purpose after September 20, 2019, by
17 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the
18 entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
19 and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before
20 September 20, 2019.

21 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
