SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Records, Communications and Compliance Division of the Department of Public Safety for the modernization program for the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System. (BDR S-1132)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Records, Communications and Compliance Division of the Department of Public Safety for the modernization program for the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of
- 3 Criminal History within the Records, Communications and
- 4 Compliance Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
- 5 \$18,643,998 for the continuing costs of the modernization program
- 6 for the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System.
- 7 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
- 8 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,



1 2023, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any
2 entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
3 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
4 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
5 after September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money
6 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
7 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
8 Fund on or before September 15, 2023.

9 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
