SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Division of Parole and Probation and the Investigation Division of the Department of Public Safety for the replacement of computer hardware and software. (BDR S-1130)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Division of Parole and Probation and the Investigation Division of the Department of Public Safety for the replacement of computer hardware and software; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Parole and Probation of the Department of Public Safety the sum of \$313,157 for the replacement of computer hardware and software.

Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 5 2. subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 6 2023, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity 7 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise 8 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated 9 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after 10 September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money was 11 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 12





granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
Fund on or before September 15, 2023.

3 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State 4 General Fund to the Investigation Division of the Department of 5 Public Safety the sum of \$66,384 for the replacement of computer 6 hardware and software.

7 Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 2. 8 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2023, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity 9 10 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise 11 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after 12 September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money was 13 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 14 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General 15 Fund on or before September 15, 2023. 16 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval. 17

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
