

SENATE BILL NO. 413—SENATORS CEGAVSKE, HARDY;
GOICOECHEA, GUSTAVSON AND SETTELMEYER

MARCH 18, 2013

Referred to Committee on Judiciary

SUMMARY—Prohibits the employment of certain persons at adult entertainment establishments. (BDR 15-1046)

AN ACT relating to crimes; prohibiting a person from employing or allowing a person who is less than 21 years of age to be a performer at an adult entertainment establishment; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill prohibits a person from employing or allowing a person who is less
2 than 21 years of age to be a performer at an adult entertainment establishment. This
3 bill also authorizes any local authority, except as otherwise provided by specific
4 statute, to enact by ordinance regulations which cover this same subject if the
5 provisions of the ordinance are not in conflict with the provisions of this bill.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 202 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. It is unlawful for a person to employ or allow a person who
4 is less than 21 years of age to be a performer at an adult
5 entertainment establishment.***

6 ***2. A person who violates subsection 1 is guilty of a
7 misdemeanor.***

1 3. Except as otherwise provided by specific statute, any local
2 authority may enact by ordinance regulations which cover the
3 same subject matter as this section if the provisions of the
4 ordinance are not in conflict with this section.

5 4. As used in this section:

6 (a) "Adult entertainment establishment" means a fixed place
7 of business which emphasizes and seeks, through one or more
8 performers, to arouse, appeal to, excite or gratify the lust, passions
9 or sexual desires of the patrons of the establishment. The term:

10 (1) Includes, without limitation, a strip club.

11 (2) Does not include a licensed brothel.

12 (b) "Performer" means a person who dances, models,
13 personally solicits or serves alcoholic or nonalcoholic beverages or
14 otherwise performs for an adult entertainment establishment and
15 who seeks to arouse, appeal to, excite or gratify the lust, passions
16 or sexual desires of the patrons of the establishment.
