AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General for a projected shortfall related to extradition costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General the sum of \$350,254 for
- 3 the Office of Extradition Coordinator budget account to cover a
- 4 projected shortfall related to extradition costs. This appropriation is
- 5 supplemental to that made by section 4 of chapter 544, Statutes of
- 6 Nevada 2019, as amended by section 18 of chapter 5, Statutes of
- 7 Nevada 2020, 31st Special Session, at page 43.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
