

SENATE BILL NO. 456—SENATOR WOODHOUSE

SUMMARY—Requires the Legislative Committee on Senior Citizens, Veterans and Adults With Special Needs to conduct a study concerning property tax assistance for senior citizens. (BDR S-1048)

AN ACT relating to property tax assistance for senior citizens; requiring the Legislative Committee on Senior Citizens, Veterans and Adults With Special Needs to conduct a study concerning property tax assistance for senior citizens; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law authorizes the Legislative Committee on Senior Citizens, Veterans
2 and Adults With Special Needs to review, study and comment upon issues relating
3 to senior citizens, including programs for the provision of services to senior
4 citizens. (NRS 218E.760) This bill requires the Committee to conduct a study
5 concerning property tax relief for senior citizens in this State, including the
6 feasibility of reenacting the Senior Citizens Property Tax Assistance Program,
7 which was repealed by the Nevada Legislature in 2011 (Chapter 391, Statutes of
8 Nevada 2011, p. 2468), and to submit a report with the results of the study and any
9 recommendations for legislation to the 80th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. The Legislative Committee on Senior Citizens,
2 Veterans and Adults With Special Needs shall conduct a study
3 during the 2017-2018 interim concerning property tax relief for
4 senior citizens in this State. The study must include, without
5 limitation:



1 (a) A determination of the feasibility of reenacting a program,
2 generally referred to as the Senior Citizens Property Tax Assistance
3 Program, which was repealed during the 76th Session of the Nevada
4 Legislature; and

5 (b) An evaluation of any alternatives which are available to
6 provide property tax assistance for senior citizens in this State.

7 2. In addition to any report required pursuant to NRS
8 218E.760, the Committee shall submit a report of the results of the
9 study and any recommendations for legislation to the Director of the
10 Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the 80th Session of
11 the Nevada Legislature.

12 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
