

SENATE BILL NO. 504—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

JUNE 4, 2011

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Authorizes and provides funding for certain projects of capital improvement. (BDR S-1316)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.  
Effect on the State: Contains Appropriation included in Executive Budget.

AN ACT relating to projects of capital improvement; authorizing certain expenditures by the State Public Works Board; levying a property tax to support the Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund; making appropriations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The State Board of Finance shall issue general obligation bonds of the State of Nevada in the face amount of not more than \$27,133,179 for the capital improvements summarized in this section. This amount is allocated to projects numbered and described in the Executive Budget for the 2011-2013 biennium or otherwise described as follows:

1 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
2 authorized in section 1 of this act must not be committed for  
3 expenditure after June 30, 2015, and must be reverted to the Bond  
4 Interest and Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest  
5 and Redemption Fund on or before September 18, 2015.

6 **Sec. 3.** 1. The State Board of Finance may issue the bonds  
7 authorized pursuant to section 1 of this act at the time deemed  
8 appropriate by the Board based on the schedule established for the  
9 completion of the projects described in that section.

10 2. The State Controller may advance temporarily from the  
11 State General Fund, upon the approval of the Chief of the Budget  
12 Division of the Department of Administration, to the State Public  
13 Works Division of the Department, until the date on which bonds  
14 authorized by section 1 of this act are sold, amounts necessary to  
15 facilitate the start of the projects enumerated in section 1 of this act.  
16 The State Controller shall not advance more than the face amount of  
17 the bonds authorized to be issued. The advanced amounts must be  
18 repaid immediately to the State General Fund upon the sale of the  
19 bonds or not later than the last business day in August immediately  
20 following the end of the fiscal year during which the advance is  
21 made.

22 3. The Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of  
23 Administration shall provide written notification to the State  
24 Controller and the Senate and Assembly Fiscal Analysts of the  
25 Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau of the  
26 approval of an advance from the State General Fund to the State  
27 Public Works Division pursuant to subsection 2.

28 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway  
29 Fund to the State Public Works Division of the Department of  
30 Administration the sum of \$2,413,578 to support the Division in  
31 carrying out the program of capital improvements summarized in  
32 this section. This amount is allocated to projects numbered and  
33 described in the Executive Budget for the 2011-2013 biennium or  
34 otherwise described as follows:

10 **Sec. 5.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
11 section 4 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
12 June 30, 2015, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or  
13 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or  
14 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
15 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
16 after September 18, 2015, by either the entity to which the money  
17 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
18 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway  
19 Fund on or before September 18, 2015.

20 **Sec. 6.** The amounts appropriated pursuant to section 4 of this  
21 act from the State Highway Fund must be allocated by the State  
22 Controller as the money is required for the projects and must not be  
23 transferred to the projects from the State Highway Fund until  
24 required to make contract payments.

25 **Sec. 7.** 1. The State Public Works Division of the  
26 Department of Administration shall transfer the sum of \$11,595,811  
27 from the amounts authorized pursuant to section 9 of chapter 440,  
28 Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2460, for the project numbered and  
29 described in the Executive Budget for the 2009-2011 biennium or  
30 otherwise described as Project 09-C02a, New 36-bed child and  
31 adolescent hospital-Southern Nevada Child and Adolescent  
32 Services, to projects as authorized in subsection 2.

33 2. The State Public Works Division shall use the \$11,595,811  
34 transferred pursuant to subsection 1 to support the Division in  
35 carrying out the program of capital improvements summarized in

29 **Sec. 8.** 1. The State Public Works Division of the  
30 Department of Administration shall transfer the sum of \$2,683,208  
31 from the amounts authorized pursuant to section 3 of chapter 347,  
32 Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1641, for the project numbered and  
33 described in the Executive Budget for the 2007-2009 biennium or  
34 otherwise described as project 07-M48, Surveillance cameras,  
35 NNCC and NSP, to projects as authorized in subsection 2.

36 2. The State Public Works Division shall use the \$2,683,208  
37 transferred pursuant to subsection 1 to support the Division in  
38 carrying out the program of capital improvements summarized in  
39 this subsection. This amount is allocated to the project numbered  
40 and described in the Executive Budget for the 2011-2013 biennium  
41 or otherwise described as project 11-M60, Surveillance cameras and  
42 recording devices-Ely State Prison.

43 **Sec. 9.** Any remaining balance of the amounts transferred in  
44 sections 7 and 8 of this act must not be committed for expenditure  
45 after June 30, 2015, and any portion of the allocated money



1 remaining must be reverted to the Bond Interest and Redemption  
2 Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund on  
3 or before September 18, 2015.

4 **Sec. 10.** Expenditure of the following sums not appropriated  
5 from the State General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby  
6 authorized for the following projects numbered and described in the  
7 Executive Budget for the 2011-2013 biennium or otherwise

28 **Sec. 11.** The State Public Works Division of the Department  
29 of Administration shall carry out the provisions of this act as  
30 provided in chapter 341 of NRS. The Division shall ensure that  
31 qualified persons are employed to accomplish the authorized work.  
32 Every contract pertaining to the work must be approved by the  
33 Attorney General.

34 **Sec. 12.** All state and local governmental agencies involved in  
35 the design and construction of the projects enumerated in this act  
36 shall cooperate with the State Public Works Division of the  
37 Department of Administration to expedite the completion of the  
38 project.

39 **Sec. 13.** The State Board of Finance shall issue general  
40 obligation bonds of the State of Nevada in the face amount of not  
41 more than \$490,000 in Fiscal Year 2011-2012, as provided in NRS  
42 233C.225, for the program for awarding financial assistance to pay  
43 the actual expenses of preserving or protecting historical buildings  
44 to be used to develop a network of cultural centers and activities.



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1       **Sec. 14.** 1. An ad valorem tax of 15.55 cents on each \$100 of  
2 assessed valuation of taxable property is hereby levied for the fiscal  
3 year commencing on July 1, 2011, and ending on June 30, 2012, and  
4 an ad valorem tax of 15.55 cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation  
5 of taxable property is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing  
6 on July 1, 2012, and ending on June 30, 2013. The taxes levied must  
7 be collected in the manner provided in chapter 361 of NRS on all  
8 taxable property in this State including the net proceeds of minerals  
9 and excluding such property as is by law exempt from taxation.  
10 Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 361.453 to the contrary,  
11 0.55 cents of the levies imposed pursuant to this subsection must not  
12 be included in calculating the limitation set forth in subsection 1 of  
13 NRS 361.453 on the total ad valorem tax levied for all public  
14 purposes.

15       2. An ad valorem tax of 1.45 cents on each \$100 of assessed  
16 valuation of taxable property is hereby levied for the fiscal year  
17 commencing on July 1, 2011, and ending on June 30, 2012, and an  
18 ad valorem tax of 1.45 cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation of  
19 taxable property is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on  
20 July 1, 2012, and ending on June 30, 2013. The taxes levied must be  
21 collected in the manner provided in chapter 361 of NRS on all  
22 taxable property in this State including the net proceeds of minerals  
23 and excluding such property as is by law exempt from taxation. The  
24 proceeds of the taxes levied pursuant to this subsection must be used  
25 exclusively for the repayment of bonded indebtedness issued  
26 pursuant to the provisions of chapter 6, Statutes of Nevada 2001,  
27 17th Special Session. Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS  
28 361.453 to the contrary, the levies imposed pursuant to this  
29 subsection must not be included in calculating the limitation set  
30 forth in subsection 1 of NRS 361.453 on the total ad valorem tax  
31 levied for all public purposes.

32       3. The proceeds of the taxes levied by this section are hereby  
33 appropriated for each fiscal year to the Consolidated Bond Interest  
34 and Redemption Fund to discharge the obligations of the State of  
35 Nevada as they are respectively due in that fiscal year. Any balance  
36 of the money appropriated by this section remaining at the end of  
37 the respective fiscal years does not revert to the State General Fund.

38       **Sec. 15.** 1. On or before July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012, the  
39 State Treasurer shall estimate the amount of proceeds of the taxes  
40 levied by section 14 of this act. If the sum of that estimate and the  
41 balance of ad valorem reserves in the Consolidated Bond Interest  
42 and Redemption Fund is less than the total obligation of the State of  
43 Nevada for payment of the interest on and principal of bonds which  
44 will become due in the fiscal year, the State Treasurer shall ask the  
45 State Controller to reserve in the State General Fund an amount



1 which is sufficient to pay the remainder of the total obligation. The  
2 State Treasurer may revise the estimate and amount reserved.

3 2. If the money in the Consolidated Bond Interest and  
4 Redemption Fund is insufficient to pay those obligations as they  
5 become due, the State Controller shall cause the money in reserve to  
6 be transferred from the State General Fund to the Consolidated  
7 Bond Interest and Redemption Fund. The amount reserved is hereby  
8 contingently appropriated for that purpose. Any balance of the sums  
9 appropriated by this subsection remaining at the end of the  
10 respective fiscal years must not be committed for expenditure after  
11 June 30 of the respective fiscal years and must be reverted to the  
12 State General Fund on or before September 21, 2012, and  
13 September 20, 2013, respectively.

14 3. The State Treasurer shall report to the Legislature or, if the  
15 Legislature is not in session, to the Interim Finance Committee:

16 (a) The amount of any estimate made pursuant to subsection 1  
17 and the amount of money reserved in the State General Fund based  
18 upon the estimate;

19 (b) The amount of money transferred from the State General  
20 Fund pursuant to subsection 2; and

21 (c) The amount of money which reverts to the State General  
22 Fund pursuant to subsection 2.

23 **Sec. 16.** The State Board of Finance, in its capacity as the  
24 State General Obligation Bond Commission and to the extent that  
25 money is available, shall pay the expenses related to the issuance of  
26 general obligation bonds approved by the 76th Session of the  
27 Nevada Legislature from the proceeds of those bonds.

28 **Sec. 17.** 1. Expenditure of the following sums not  
29 appropriated from the State General Fund or the State Highway  
30 Fund is hereby authorized from the Consolidated Bond Interest and  
31 Redemption Fund in the amount of \$157,663,910 for the fiscal year  
32 beginning on July 1, 2011, and ending on June 30, 2012, and in the  
33 amount of \$167,264,898 for the fiscal year beginning on July 1,  
34 2012, and ending on June 30, 2013.

35 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 4 of NRS  
36 353.220, the approval of the Interim Finance Committee is not  
37 required for any request for the revision of a work program for any  
38 account within the Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption  
39 Fund for the payment of principal, interest and related costs of  
40 issuance for securities approved by the State Legislature pursuant to  
41 the provisions of this act.

42 **Sec. 18.** With the approval of the Interim Finance Committee,  
43 the State Public Works Division of the Department of  
44 Administration and the Nevada System of Higher Education may  
45 transfer appropriated, allocated and authorized money from one



1 project to another within the same agency or within the Nevada  
2 System of Higher Education for those projects listed in sections 1, 7  
3 and 19 of this act.

4 **Sec. 19.** The money collected pursuant to the annual tax on  
5 slot machines imposed pursuant to NRS 463.385 that is distributed  
6 to the Special Capital Construction Fund for Higher Education,  
7 except any amount of that money which is needed to pay the  
8 principal and interest on bonds, is appropriated to the State Public  
9 Works Division of the Department of Administration in the sum of  
10 \$5,000,000 for the project numbered and described in the Executive  
11 Budget for the 2011-2013 biennium or otherwise described as  
12 project 11-M39, NSHE Deferred Maintenance (HECC/SHECC).

13 **Sec. 20.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
14 section 19 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
15 June 30, 2015, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or  
16 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or  
17 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
18 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
19 after September 18, 2015, by either the entity to which the money  
20 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
21 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the fund of origin on  
22 or before September 18, 2015.

23 **Sec. 21.** Section 5 of chapter 585, Statutes of Nevada 2001, as  
24 last amended by section 29 of chapter 440, Statutes of Nevada 2009,  
25 at page 2466, is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 Sec. 5. 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section,  
27 any remaining balance of the allocated amounts authorized in  
28 section 4 of chapter 585, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page  
29 2995, must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,  
30 2005, and must be reverted to the Bond Interest and  
31 Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest and  
32 Redemption Fund on or before September 16, 2005.

33 2. Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
34 authorized in section 4 of chapter 585, Statutes of Nevada  
35 2001, at page 2995, for project 01-C4, New State Motor Pool  
36 building, must not be committed for expenditure after  
37 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the Bond Interest and  
38 Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest and  
39 Redemption Fund on or before September 21, 2007.

40 3. Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
41 authorized in section 4 of chapter 585, Statutes of Nevada  
42 2001, at page 2995, for project 01-C16, furnishings and build-  
43 out, Redfield campus, phase I, UNR, must not be committed  
44 for expenditure after June 30, 2006, and must be reverted to  
45 the Bond Interest and Redemption Account in the



1 Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund on or  
2 before September 15, 2006.

3 4. Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
4 authorized in section 4 of chapter 585, Statutes of Nevada  
5 2001, at page 2995, for the following projects, must not be  
6 committed for expenditure after June 30, 2007, and must be  
7 reverted to the Bond Interest and Redemption Account in the  
8 Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund on or  
9 before September 21, 2007:
