

SENATE BILL NO. 65—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

(ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WEST WENDOVER)

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Department of Motor Vehicles for providing certain services to the City of West Wendover and the City of Caliente. (BDR S-444)

AN ACT making appropriations from the State Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles for providing certain services to the City of West Wendover and the City of Caliente; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles for the travel,
- 3 equipment and operating expenses of a mobile traveling team to
- 4 perform driver’s license and identification card services in the City
- 5 of West Wendover the following sums:
- 6 For the Fiscal Year 2019-2020..... \$41,118
- 7 For the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 \$28,895
- 8 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund
- 9 to the Department of Motor Vehicles for the travel, equipment and
- 10 operating expenses of a mobile traveling team to perform driver’s
- 11 license and identification card services in the City of Caliente the
- 12 following sums:



1 For the Fiscal Year 2019-2020..... \$41,215
 2 For the Fiscal Year 2020-2021..... \$29,188

3 3. Any balance of the sums appropriated by subsections 1 and
 4 2 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be
 5 committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal
 6 years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any
 7 entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
 8 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
 9 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
 10 after September 18, 2020, and September 17, 2021, respectively, by
 11 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity
 12 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
 13 and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before
 14 September 18, 2020, and September 17, 2021, respectively.

15 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
 16 Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of
 17 \$12,437 for the costs of creating an electronic connection between
 18 the Department and the City Hall in the City of West Wendover to
 19 provide vehicle registration services in the City of West Wendover.

20 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
 21 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
 22 2020, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any
 23 entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
 24 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
 25 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
 26 after September 18, 2020, by either the entity to which the money
 27 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
 28 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway
 29 Fund on or before September 18, 2020.

30 **Sec. 3.** The appropriations made by the provisions of this act
 31 are not intended to finance ongoing expenditures of state agencies,
 32 and the expenditures financed with those appropriations must be
 33 included as base budget expenditures in the proposed budget for the
 34 Executive Branch of State Government for the 2021-2023 biennium.

35 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval
 36 for the purposes of performing any preparatory administrative tasks
 37 that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act, and on
 38 July 1, 2019, for all other purposes.
