AN ACT relating to state employees; increasing the maximum salary of certain state employees; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law provides that the salary of certain state employees must not exceed provides the Governor's salary. (NRS 281.123) This bill increases the limit on

3 the salary of such state employees to 150 percent of the Governor's salary.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 281.123 is hereby amended to read as follows: 281.123 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3 or NRS 281.1233, or as authorized by statute referring specifically to that position, the salary of a person employed by the State or any agency of the State must not exceed [95] 150 percent of the salary for the office of Governor during the same period.

- 2. As used in subsection 1, the term "salary":
- (a) Includes any:

9 (1) Payment received by an employee for being available to 10 work although the employee was not actually required to perform 11 the work;

12 (2) Increase in salary provided to compensate for a rise in the 13 cost of living; and

14 (3) Payment received as compensation for purportedly 15 performing additional duties.

- (b) Excludes any: 1

(1) Payment received as compensation for overtime even if 2 that payment is otherwise authorized by law; and 3

(2) Rent or utilities supplied to an employee if the employee 4 5 is required by statute or regulation to live in a particular dwelling.

The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to the salaries 6 3. of: 7 8

(a) Dentists and physicians employed full-time by the State; or

(b) Officers and employees of the Nevada System of Higher 9 10 Education.

This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021. 11 Sec. 2.
