## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman James R. Wert Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route (S.R.) 88 between Loomis Parkway and S.R. 14, in Portage County
Other Information	Patrolman James R. Wert was killed on January 31, 1981, after he was struck by a drunk driver on S.R. 88 while on duty. He worked for the Ravenna Police Department and previously served as a U.S. Army Military Police Officer.
