S.B. 111 of the 134th General Assembly

Appropriations changes

- Removes the bill's provisions making appropriations to the departments of Education, Health, and the Adjutant General. Similar provisions were enacted in H.B. 170 of the 134th General Assembly.
- Appropriates \$422 million in FY 2022 to the Office of Budget and Management for distribution to local governments, based on population, in accordance with the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. (The LSC Fiscal Note is available here.)

Prohibition on certain mandatory vaccinations and discriminatory treatment

- Prohibits a private or public entity from doing either of the following:
 - □ Requiring an individual to receive a vaccine that is not yet fully approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration;
 - □ Requiring an individual who has not received such a vaccine to engage in or refrain from engaging in activities or precautions that differ from those of an individual who has elected to receive such a vaccine.
- Specifies that the prohibitions do not apply to private residences.
