## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3702.3012 and 3727.25 of the	3	
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:		
Sec. 3702.3012. (A) As used in this section, "surgical	5	
smoke" and "surgical smoke evacuation system" have the same	6	
meanings as in section 3727.25 of the Revised Code.	7	
(B) Not later than one year after the effective date of	8	
this section, each ambulatory surgical facility shall adopt and	9	
implement a policy designed to prevent human exposure to	10	
surgical smoke during any planned surgical procedure that is	11	
likely to generate surgical smoke. The policy shall include the	12	
use of a surgical smoke evacuation system.	13	
(C) The director of health may adopt any rules the	14	
director considers necessary to implement this section. The	15	
rules shall be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the		
Revised Code.		

Sec. 3727.25. (A) As used in this section:		
(1) "Surgical smoke" means the airborne byproduct of an	19	
energy-generating device used in a surgical procedure, including		
smoke plume, bioaerosols, gases, laser-generated contaminants,		
and dust.	22	
(2) "Surgical smoke evacuation system" means equipment	23	
designed to capture, filter, and eliminate surgical smoke at the	24	
point of origin, before the smoke makes contact with the eyes or	25	
respiratory tract of individuals.	26	
(B) Not later than one year after the effective date of	27	
this section, each hospital that offers surgical services shall	28	
adopt and implement a policy designed to prevent human exposure	29	
to surgical smoke during any planned surgical procedure that is	30	
likely to generate surgical smoke. The policy shall include the	31	
use of a surgical smoke evacuation system.	32	
(C) The director of health may adopt any rules the	33	
director considers necessary to implement this section. The		
rules shall be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the	35	
Revised Code.	36
