BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 315.02 of the Revised Code be	4							
amended to read as follows:								
Sec. 315.02. (A) No person holding the office of clerk of	6							
the court of common pleas, sheriff, county treasurer, or county								
recorder is eligible to hold the office of county engineer. No-	8							
(B)(1) Except as provided in division (B)(2) of this	9							
section, no person is eligible in any county as a candidate for	10							
such the office of county engineer or shall be elected or	11							
appointed thereto unless he<u>the person</u> is a registered								
professional engineer and a registered surveyor, licensed to								
practice in this state.	14							
(2) In a county with a population of less than forty	15							
thousand according to the most recent federal decennial census,	16							
a person being elected or appointed to the person's first term	17							
as county engineer in that county is not required to be a	18							
registered surveyor licensed to practice in this state.
