Section 1. That section 4509.105 of the Revised Code be	7
enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 4509.105. (A) A driver who fails to maintain proof of	9
financial responsibility as required under this chapter at the	10
time of an accident shall have no cause of action for recovery	11
of damages for noneconomic loss sustained as a proximate result	12
of an accident while operating a motor vehicle if at any time in	13
the seven years preceding the accident the driver's operating	14
privileges and the driver's license were impounded for a	15
violation of division (A)(1) of section 4509.101 of the Revised	16
Code.	17

(B) Division (A) of this section does not apply if the	18
noneconomic loss sustained by the driver is caused by either of	19
the following:	20
(1) An individual who pleads quilty to or is convicted of	21
committing an offense for which four or six points are assessed	22
against that individual under section 4510.036 of the Revised	23
Code;	24
(2) An individual who pleads guilty to or is convicted of	25
texting while driving in violation of section 4511.204 of the	26
Revised Code.	27
(C) Division (A) of this section does not apply to either	28
