BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3737.52 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3737.52. (A) As used in this section:	7
(1) "Class B firefighting foam" means a foam that is	8
designed to extinguish a fire caused by flammable liquid.	9
(2) "PFAS chemicals" means a class of fluorinated organic	10
chemicals containing at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom,	11
including perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, that	12
are designed to be fully functional in class B firefighting foam	13
formulations.	14
(3) "Testing" includes calibration testing, conformance	15

testing, and fixed system testing.	16
(B) No person shall use a class B firefighting foam	17
containing intentionally added PFAS chemicals for training	18
purposes.	19
(C)(1) Except as provided in division (C)(2) of this	20
section, no person shall use a class B firefighting foam	21
containing intentionally added PFAS chemicals for testing	22
purposes.	23
(2) A person may use a class B firefighting foam	24
containing intentionally added PFAS chemicals for testing	25
purposes if the testing facility has implemented appropriate	26
containment, treatment, and disposal measures to prevent	27
releases of the class B firefighting foam into the environment.	28
(D) Nothing in this section restricts either of the	29
<pre>following:</pre>	30
(1) The manufacture, sale, or distribution of class B	31
firefighting foam containing intentionally added PFAS chemicals.	32
(2) The use of class B firefighting foam containing	33
intentionally added PFAS chemicals in emergency firefighting or	34
fire prevention operations.	35
(E) For purposes of using foam during firefighting	36
operations training, a person may use a training foam that does	37
not contain intentionally added PFAS chemicals.	38
