A BILL

To enact section 5534.415 of the Revised Code to 1
designate a portion of Interstate Route 275 in 2
Hamilton County as the "Officer Kaia L. Grant 3
Memorial Highway." 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.415 of the Revised Code be 5
enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 5534.415. In addition to any other name prescribed by 7
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 8
of interstate route number two hundred seventy-five between the 9
intersection of that route and Winton road and the intersection 10
of that route and interstate route number seventy-five, in 11
Hamilton county, shall be known as the "Officer Kaia L. Grant 12
Memorial Highway." 13

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 14
along the highway indicating its name. 15
