A BILL

To enact section 3319.078 of the Revised Code to 1
require city, exempted village, and local school 2
districts to employ, for each 1,000 students, at 3
least five full-time equivalent educational 4
service personnel in specified areas. 5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3319.078 of the Revised Code be 6
enacted to read as follows: 7

Sec. 3319.078. (A) Each city, exempted village, or local 8
school district shall employ, for each one thousand students in 9
the regular student population, a minimum of five full-time 10
equivalent educational service personnel. The educational 11
service personnel employed pursuant to this division shall be 12
assigned to at least five of the following positions: 13

(1) School counselor; 14

(2) Librarian or library media specialist; 15

(3) School nurse; 16

<u>(4) Technology instructor;</u>	17
<u>(5) School social worker;</u>	18
<u>(6) Instructor for limited English proficient students;</u>	19
<u>(7) Elementary school art teacher;</u>	20
<u>(8) Elementary school music teacher;</u>	21
<u>(9) Elementary school physical education teacher.</u>	22
<u>(B) As used in this section, "regular student population"</u>	23
<u>means the formula ADM of a school district, as defined in</u>	24
<u>section 3317.02 of the Revised Code, plus the number of students</u>	25
<u>reported as enrolled in the district under division (A) (1) of</u>	26
<u>section 3313.981 of the Revised Code, minus the enrollment of</u>	27
<u>students reported under division (A) (2) of section 3317.03 of</u>	28
<u>the Revised Code, minus the full-time equivalency of the</u>	29
<u>students reported under divisions (B) (5), (6), (7), (8), (9),</u>	30
<u>(10), (11), (12), (13), (14), and (15) of section 3317.03 of the</u>	31
<u>Revised Code, minus twenty per cent of the students enrolled</u>	32
<u>concurrently in a joint vocational school district.</u>	33
