BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4507.04 of the Revised Code be	5
amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4507.04. (A) Nonresidents, permitted to drive upon	7
the highways of their own state, may operate any motor vehicle	8
upon any highway in this state without examination or license	9
under sections 4507.01 to 4507.39, inclusive, of the Revised	10
Code, upon condition that such nonresidents may be required at	11
any time or place to prove lawful possession, or their right to	12
operate, such motor vehicle, and to establish proper identity.	13
(B) (1) Nonresidents, permitted to drive upon the highways	14
of their own country, if that country is a signatory to a	15
convention regarding driver's license reciprocity and the United	16
States is also a signatory to that convention, may operate any	17

(2) A nonresident from another country may, but is not	26
required to, obtain and carry an international driving permit to	27
help establish that nonresident's identity and right to operate	
a motor vehicle. An international driving permit does not	
replace an original driver's license or the requirement to	30
present an original driver's license issued by the nonresident's	31

Section 2. That existing section 4507.04 of the Revised	33

Code is hereby repealed.
