Section 1. That section 909.19 of the Revised Code be	5

Sec. 909.19. (A) A person that registers an apiary under	7
section 909.02 of the Revised Code is not liable for any	8
personal injury or property damage that occurs as a result of a	
bee sting or multiple bee stings by bees from that apiary if the	
person does all of the following:	
(1) Implements and is in compliance with beekeeping	12
industry best management practices as established by a state-	
wide beekeeping association;	
(2) Keeps correct and complete records of implementation	15
