## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	6
4503.565 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	8
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	9
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	10
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to	11
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.496,	12
4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 4503.505,	13
4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526,	14
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552,	15
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, <u>4503.565,</u>	16
4503.576, 4503.591, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701,	17
4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.72, 4503.73,	18

4503.732, 4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.89, 19 4503.90, 4503.92, and 4503.94 of the Revised Code. 20 (B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 21 registrar collects in the fund as follows: 22 The registrar shall pay the contributions received 23 pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 24 cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 25 programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 26 cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 27 quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 28 the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 29 other abortion-related activities. 30 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 31 receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 32

organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received39pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism40society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs41and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.42

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar43receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the44national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal45amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley46chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These47

chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to48assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services49directly to their clients.50

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 51 receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 52 Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 53 contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 54 support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 55

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 56 receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 57 special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 58 for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 59

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar60receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the61children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the62contributions for its research and other programs.63

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 64 receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 65 future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 66 contributions into its general account to be used for 67 educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 68 America foundation. 69

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 70 receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 71 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 72 extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 73 the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 74

The registrar shall pay the contributions received75pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio76

cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 77 scholarships and other educational activities. 78 The registrar shall pay the contributions received 79 pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 80 organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 81 contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 82 that organization. 83 The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 84 receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 85 university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 86 collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 87 section. A university or college that receives contributions 88 from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 89 scholarship fund. 90 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 91 receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 92 "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 93 incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 94 of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 95

expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 96 educational, and cultural events at the monument. 97

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 98 receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 99 fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 100 the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 101 lighthouses of fairport harbor. 102

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar103receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the104Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the105

contributions only to promote and support the football team of 106 Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 107

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 108 receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 109 United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty-110 four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 111 district shall use the money it receives under this section to 112 pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 113 sponsors within this state. 114

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 115 receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 116 Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 117 international, which shall use the money it receives under this 118 section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian activities. 120

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 121 receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 122 thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 123 organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 124 organization in paying for the charitable activities and 125 programs it sponsors in support of United States military 126 personnel, veterans, and their families. 127

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 128 receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 129 disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 130 programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 131 families. 132

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 133 receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 134

pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions135into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall136be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football137hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose138of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel139destination.140

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 141 the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 142 to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 143 the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 144 programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 145

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 146 contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 147 4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 148 source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 149 designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 150 Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 151 section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 152 cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 153 veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 154 pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 155 maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 156

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar157receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the158rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated.159

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar160receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the161Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit162corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section,163the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the164

members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 165 charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 166 provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 167 Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 168 for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 169 promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 170 incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 171 under this section. 172

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 173 receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 174 Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 175 the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 176 programs. 177

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 178 receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 179 state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 180 deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 181 establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 182 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 183 ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 184 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 185 managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 186 Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 187 registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 188 such payments are to be made. 189

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 190 receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 191 Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 192 expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 193 river watershed. 194 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar195receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to196Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute197to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve.198

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use the money in support of the park.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational information about beekeeping, and to support other state and local beekeeping programs.

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 209 pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 210 contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 211 applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 212 professional sports team located in the county of that sports 213 commission and that is participating in the license plate 214 program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 215 of the county of residence of an applicant. 216

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each217contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of218the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates219that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is220participating in the license plate program pursuant to division221(G) of that section.222

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 224 Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 225 shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 226 throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 227

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 228 receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 229 great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 230 America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 231 equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 232 the girl scouts. 233

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar243receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the244fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall245deposit the fees into its general account to be used for246purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.247

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 248 receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 249 fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 250 deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 251 used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 252

enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 253 methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 254

The registrar shall pay the contributions received255pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio256concerns of police survivors, which shall use those257contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate258to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed259in the line of duty.260

The registrar shall pay the contributions received261pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater262Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those263contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in264the line of duty and support its charitable purposes.265

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 266 receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 267 organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 268 association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 269 Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 270 shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 271 administering a program to secure the proper representation in 272 the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 273 children, and for the training and supervision of persons 274 participating in that program. 275

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar276receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to277Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the278contributions into its general account to be used for purposes279of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated.280

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 282 Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 283 commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 284 Cleveland, Ohio. 285

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 286 receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 287 Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 288 moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 289 4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 290 agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 291

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 292 receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 293 rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 294 Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 295 used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 296 rotary foundation. 297

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 298 receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 299 Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 300 contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 301 under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 302

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 303 receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 304 Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 305 research projects. 306

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar307receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the308Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those309contributions solely to promote and support the historical310

preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 313 receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 314 American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 315 chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 316 contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 317 programs on a statewide basis. 318

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the nationwide children's hospital foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed forces of the United States and their families when they are in financial need.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint vocational school districts.

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this

section the investment income the fund earned the previous340calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an341entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity342received from the fund during the previous calendar year.343

Sec. 4503.565. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 344 car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 345 vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 346 may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 347 and the issuance of Cuyahoga valley national park license 348 plates. An application made under this section may be combined 349 with a request for a special reserved license plate under 350 section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of 351 the completed application and compliance by the applicant with 352 divisions (B) and (C) of this section, the registrar shall issue 353 to the applicant the appropriate vehicle registration and a set 354 of Cuyahoga valley national park license plates and a validation 355 sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required by section 356 4503.191 of the Revised Code. 357

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily\_ 358 inscribed on the license plates, Cuyahoga valley national park 359 license plates shall be inscribed with identifying words or 360 markings that are designed by the conservancy for Cuyahoga 361 valley national park, and approved by the registrar. Cuyahoga 362 valley national park license plates shall display county 363 identification stickers that identify the county of registration 364 by name or number. 365

(B) Cuyahoga valley national park license plates and a366validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone, shall be367issued upon receipt of a contribution as provided in division368(C) (1) of this section and upon payment of the regular license369

tax as prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any	370	
applicable motor vehicle license tax levied under Chapter 4504.		
of the Revised Code, any applicable additional fee prescribed by		
section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, a bureau of	373	
motor vehicles administrative fee of ten dollars, and compliance

(C)(1) For each application for registration and	377	
registration renewal notice the registrar receives under this	378	
section, the registrar shall collect a contribution of fifteen	379	
dollars. The registrar shall deposit this contribution into the	380	
state treasury to the credit of the license plate contribution	381	
fund created in section 4501.21 of the Revised Code.		
(2) The registrar shall deposit the bureau administrative	383	
fee of ten dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the		
bureau for additional services required in the issuing of		
Cuyahoga valley national park license plates, into the state		
treasury to the credit of the state bureau of motor vehicles		
fund created in section 4501.25 of the Revised Code.
