Section 1. That sections 3792.05 and 4113.73 of the	7
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3792.05. (A) As used in this section:	9
(1) "Place of public accommodation" has the same meaning	10
as in section 4112.01 of the Revised Code.	11
(2) "Private college" has the same meaning as in section	12

(3) "Proof of COVID-19 vaccination status" means a paper	14
document or a digital application available on a smartphone,	15

(B) No employer shall discharge without just cause, refuse	57	
to hire, or otherwise discriminate against any person with		
respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of	59	
employment, or any matter directly or indirectly related to	60	
employment, for either of the following reasons:	61	
(1) The person has not been or will not be vaccinated	62
