A BILL

To amend sections 733.72 and 733.77 of the Revised	1
Code to require a party filing a complaint	2
against a municipal officer to pay the officer's	3
legal expenses if the officer is acquitted.	4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 733.72 and 733.77 of the Revised	5
Code be amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 733.72. When a complaint under oath is filed with the	7
probate judge of the county in which a municipal corporation or	8
the larger part thereof is situated, by any elector of the	9
municipal corporation, signed and approved by four other	10
electors thereof, the judge shall forthwith issue a citation to	11
any person charged in the complaint for his the person's	12
appearance before the judge within ten days from the filing	13
thereof, and shall also furnish the accused and the village	14
solicitor or city director of law with a copy thereof. The	15
complaint shall charge any of the following:	16
(A) That a member of the legislative authority of the	17
municipal corporation has received, directly or indirectly,	18
compensation for his services as a member thereof, as a	19

<pre>committeeman_committeeperson, or otherwise, contrary to law;</pre>	20
(B) That a member of the legislative authority or an	21
officer of the municipal corporation is or has been interested,	22
directly or indirectly, in the profits of a contract, job, work,	23
or service, or is or has been acting as a commissioner,	24
architect, superintendent, or engineer in work undertaken or	25
prosecuted by the municipal corporation, contrary to law;	26
(C) That a member of the legislative authority or an	27
officer of the municipal corporation has been guilty of	28
misfeasance or malfeasance in office.	29
Before acting upon such complaint, the judge shall require	30
the party complaining to furnish sufficient security for costs	31
and expenses, including the accused's legal expenses.	32
Sec. 733.77. The cost costs and expenses of the trial,	33
including the accused's legal expenses, shall be charged against	34
the party filing the complaint under section 733.72 of the	35
Revised Code if the accused is acquitted upon trial. Otherwise,	36
the costs and expenses shall be charged against the party filing	37
the complaint, the accused, or the municipal corporation, or	38
apportioned among them, as the probate judge directs, and shall	39
be collected as in other cases. No costs or expenses shall be	40
charged to the accused if he is acquitted upon trial. If an	41
appeal on questions of law is instituted by the officer	42
complained of, to reverse or vacate the order of the probate	43
court, such officer shall not exercise the functions of his-	44
office until <u>the</u> order is finally reversed or vacated.	45
Section 2. That existing sections 733.72 and 733.77 of the	46
Revised Code are hereby repealed.	47

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
