## A BILL

To enact section 5517.06 of the Revised Code to	1
require the Director of Transportation to	2
conduct a traffic noise analysis and to	3
construct noise barriers under specified	4
circumstances.	5

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5517.06 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 5517.06. (A) The director of transportation shall_	8
conduct a traffic noise analysis to determine if noise abatement	9
measures for existing residential and business communities are	10
reasonable and feasible during construction of any of the	11
following:	
(1) A new interstate highway near the residential or	13
business community;	14
(2) A substantial horizontal or vertical alteration of an	15
existing interstate highway near the residential or business	16
community;	17
(3) One or more additional through-traffic lanes or	18

auxiliary lanes on an existing interstate highway near the	
residential or business community.	
(B) After conducting a traffic noise analysis under_	21
division (A) of this section, the director shall construct a	22
noise barrier that will result in a reduction of the noise	23
levels by at least seven A-weighted decibels for an existing	24
residential or business community if all of the following apply:	
	0.6
(1) The traffic noise analysis indicates that the	26
construction described in division (A) of this section will	27
result in a substantial noise increase of ten A-weighted	28
decibels for the existing residential or business community.	29
(2) The construction of the noise barrier is reasonable.	30
(3) The construction of the noise barrier is feasible.	31
(C) The director shall examine any construction projects	32
initiated within the ten years prior to the effective date of	33
this section that are described under division (A) of this	34
section. If a traffic noise analysis was not conducted at the	35
time of the construction, the director shall conduct a noise	36
analysis. The director shall construct a noise barrier in	37
accordance with division (B) of this section if the results of	38
the noise analysis require such construction.	
(D) The director shall adopt rules in accordance with	40
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code and that are consistent with 23	41
C.F.R. part 772, as amended, in order to implement this section.	
Section 2. This act shall be known as the "Community Sound	43
Barrier Reconciliation Act."	

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
