## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) As used in this section: 6
(1) "Eligible student" means a student who received an 7 award under the Ohio College Opportunity Grant program 8 established under section 3333.122 of the Revised Code in the 9 2019-2020 academic year. 10
(2) "State institution of higher education" has the same
(B) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section
received under that program for the 2019-2020 academic year. A 20
state institution of higher education shall apply an award 21
prescribed under this section to a student's general and 22
instructional fees prior to applying that student's Pell grant 23
to those fees. No award amount under this section shall exceed 24
the total state cost of attendance, except as provided in 25
divisions (D) (4) and (5) of section 3333.122 of the Revised 26
Code.
Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to ensure that the changes made by this act take effect before the start of the 2020-2021 academic year. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.
