## A BILL

To enact sections 3902.30, 5164.061, and 5167.15 of	1
the Revised Code to require health insurers and	2
the Medicaid program to provide coverage for	3
chiropractic and other services when prescribed	4
as alternatives to opioid analgesics.	5

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3902.30, 5164.061, and 5167.15 of	6
the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 3902.30. (A) As used in this section:	8
(1) "Health benefit plan" has the same meaning as in	9
section 3922.01 of the Revised Code.	10
(2) "Opioid analgesic" has the same meaning as in section	11
3719.01 of the Revised Code.	12
(B) Notwithstanding section 3901.71 of the Revised Code, a	13
health benefit plan issued, modified, or renewed on or after the	14
effective date of this section shall cover the following	15
services if prescribed by a physician, advanced practice	16
registered nurse, or physician assistant as an alternative to	17
treatment with an opioid analgesic:	18

(1) Acupuncture, as defined in section 4762.01 of the	19
Revised Code;	20
(2) Chiropractic, as defined in section 4734.01 of the	21
Revised Code;	22
(3) Massage therapy, as defined in section 4731.04 of the	23
Revised Code;	24
(4) Physical therapy, as defined in section 4755.40 of the	25
Revised Code.	26
(C)(1) The coverage described in division (B) of this	27
section shall be provided only when such services are provided	28
by an individual authorized by the Revised Code to provide those	29
services.	30
(2) A health benefit plan shall not impose limits on the	31
number of visits covered under this section.	32
Sec. 5164.061. (A) As used in this section, "opioid	33
analgesic" has the same meaning as in section 3719.01 of the	34
Revised Code.	35
(B) Subject to division (C) of this section, the medicaid	36
program shall cover the following services if prescribed by a	37
physician, advanced practice registered nurse, or physician	38
assistant as an alternative to treatment with an opioid	39
analgesic:	40
(1) Acupuncture, as defined in section 4762.01 of the	41
Revised Code;	42

(2) Chiropractic, as defined in section 4734.01 of the43Revised Code;44

(3) Massage therapy, as defined in section 4731.04 of the

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Revised Code;	46
(4) Physical therapy, as defined in section 4755.40 of the	47
Revised Code.	48
(C)(1) The services described in division (B) of this	49
section shall be provided only by an individual authorized by	50
the Revised Code to provide such services.	51
(2) The medicaid program shall not establish limits on the	52
number of visits for services that a medicaid recipient may	53
receive under this section.	54
Sec. 5167.15. When contracting under section 5167.10 of	55
the Revised Code with a medicaid managed care organization, the	56
department of medicaid shall require the organization to comply	57
with section 5164.061 of the Revised Code as if the organization	58
were the department.	59
