BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 . That sections 4723.283, 4729.261, 4730.253, and	5
4731.201 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4723.283. The board of nursing shall not revoke,	7
suspend, or place restrictions on a license to practice as an	8
advanced practice registered nurse held by a certified nurse	9
practitioner or clinical nurse specialist or reprimand or	10
otherwise discipline the holder of such a license solely for	11
issuing a prescription for a drug to be used in a manner other	12
than the use approved by the United States food and drug	13
administration, except when the issuance of such a prescription	14
conflicts with acceptable and prevailing standards of safe	15
nursing care.	16
Sec. 4729.261. (A) As used in this section:	17

(1) "Certified nurse practitioner" and "clinical nurse	18
specialist" have the same meanings as in section 4723.01 of the	19
Revised Code.	20
(2) "Physician" means an individual authorized under_	21
Chapter 4731. of the Revised Code to practice medicine and	22
surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery.	23

(3) "Physician assistant" means an individual authorized	24

(B) With respect to a drug that is prescribed for a	27
patient by a certified nurse practitioner, clinical nurse	28
specialist, physician, or physician assistant for use in a	29
manner other than the use approved by the United States food and	30
drug administration, including chloroquine or	31
hydroxychloroquine, the state board of pharmacy shall not adopt	32
a rule to prohibit a terminal distributor of dangerous drugs	33
from selling the drug at retail or a pharmacist or pharmacy	34
intern from dispensing the drug.	35
