## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and sections 6 7 4503.436 and 4503.566 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 8 Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state 9 treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 10 consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 11 and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 12 sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 13 4503.496, 4503.497, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 14 4503.502, 4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.514, 4503.522, 4503.523, 15 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 4503.531, 16 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 4503.553, 17 4503.554, 4503.555, 4503.556, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 18 4503.565, <u>4503.566</u>, 4503.576, 4503.577, 4503.591, 4503.592, 19

The registrar shall pay the contributions received	45
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism	46
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs	47
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.	48

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 49 receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 50 national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 51 amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 52 chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 53 chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 54 assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 55 directly to their clients. 56

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with pancreatic cancer and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar67receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the68St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for69its research and other programs.70

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 71 receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 72 special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 73 for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 74

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 75 receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 76 children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 77

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contributions for its research and other programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 79 receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 80 future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 81 contributions into its general account to be used for 82 educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 83 America foundation. 84

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 85 receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 86 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 87 extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 88 the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 89

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 90 pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 91 cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 92 scholarships and other educational activities. 93

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 94 pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 95 organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 96 contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 97 that organization. 98

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 99 receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 100 university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 101 collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 102 section. A university or college that receives contributions 103 from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 104 scholarship fund. 105

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 107 university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 108 awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 109 the university. The university shall not use more than twenty 110 per cent of the funds it receives for purposes of administering 111 the scholarship program. The registrar shall enter into 112 113 appropriate agreements with the university of Notre Dame to effectuate the distribution of such funds as provided in this 114 section. 115

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 116 receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 117 "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 118 incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 119 of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 120 expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 121 educational, and cultural events at the monument. 122

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar123receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the124fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for125the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the126lighthouses of fairport harbor.127

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar128receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the129Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the130contributions only to promote and support the football team of131Washington high school of the Massillon city school district.132

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar133receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the134United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty-135four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron136

district shall use the money it receives under this section to137pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or138sponsors within this state.139

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 140 receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 141 Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 142 international, which shall use the money it receives under this 143 section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 144 activities. 145

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 146 receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 147 Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the 148 money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it 149 incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the 150 provision of services to children, young adults, and families in 151 this state. 152

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 153 receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 154 Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 155 receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 156 to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 157 to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 158 their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 159 research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 160 the improvement of patient outcomes. 161

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar162receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the163thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation164organized under the laws of this state, to assist that165organization in paying for the charitable activities and166

programs it sponsors in support of United States military 167 personnel, veterans, and their families. 168

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar169receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the170disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for171programs that serve disabled American veterans and their172families.173

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 174 receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 175 pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 176 into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 177 be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 178 hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 179 of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 180 destination. 181

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 182 the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 183 to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 184 the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 185 programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 186

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 187 contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 188 4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 189 source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 190 designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 191 Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 192 section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 193 cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 194 veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 195 pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 196 maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 197

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar198receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the199rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated.200

201 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 202 Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 203 corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 204 205 the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 206 charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 207 provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 208 Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 209 for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 210 promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 211 incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 212 under this section. 213

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 214 receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 215 Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 216 the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 217 programs. 218

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar219receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the220western reserve historical society, which shall use the221contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum.222

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar223receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the224Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple225

negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the 226 contributions for charitable and educational purposes. 227

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 228 receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 229 state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 230 deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 231 establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 232 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 233 ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 234 235 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 236 Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 237 registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 238 such payments are to be made. 239

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning river watershed.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar245receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to246Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute247to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve.248

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 249 receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 250 conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 251 the money in support of the park. 252

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar253receives pursuant to section 4503.566 of the Revised Code to the254

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Ottawa national wildlife refuge, which shall use the	255	
contributions for wildlife preservation purposes.		
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	257	
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the	258	
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those	259

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	282

pollinator partnership's monarch wings across Ohio program,284which shall use the contributions for the protection and285preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in286Ohio and for educational programs.287

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 293 receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 294 great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 295 America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 296 equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 297 the girl scouts. 298

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 304 receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 305 Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 306 which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 307

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 308 receives pursuant to section 4503.702 of the Revised Code to the 309 Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order 310 of the Elks of the World, which shall use the funds for 311 charitable purposes. 312

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar313receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the314fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall315deposit the fees into its general account to be used for316purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.317

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 318 receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 319 fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 320 deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 321 used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 322 enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 323 methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 324

The registrar shall pay the contributions received325pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio326concerns of police survivors, which shall use those327contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate328to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed329in the line of duty.330

The registrar shall pay the contributions received331pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater332Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those333contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in334the line of duty and support its charitable purposes.335

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 336 receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 337 fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 338 to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 339 families. 340

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 342 organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 343 association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 344 Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 345 shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 346 administering a program to secure the proper representation in 347 the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 348 children, and for the training and supervision of persons 349 participating in that program. 350

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.722 of the Revised Code to the Down Syndrome Association of Central Ohio, which shall use the contributions for advocacy purposes throughout the state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar355receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to356Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the357contributions into its general account to be used for purposes358of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated.359

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 360 receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 361 Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 362 commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 363 Cleveland, Ohio. 364

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 365 receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to the 366 Ohio chapter of the juvenile diabetes research foundation in 367 whose geographic territory the person who paid the contribution 368 resides. 369

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 371 Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 372 moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 373 4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 374 agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 375

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 376 receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 377 rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 378 Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 379 used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 380 rotary foundation. 381

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 382 receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 383 Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 384 contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 385 under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 386

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar387receives pursuant to section 4503.752 of the Revised Code to388buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the389contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs.390

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 391 receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 392 Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 393 maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 394 connection. 395

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 396 receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 397 Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 398 research projects. 399

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 400 receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 401 Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 402 contributions solely to promote and support the historical 403 preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 404 state. 405

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar406receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the407Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those408contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth409baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City.410

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 411 receives pursuant to section 4503.871 of the Revised Code to the 412 Solon city school district. The school district shall use the 413 contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in 414 providing services to the school district's students that assist 415 in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being 416 of the students. The services provided may include bereavement 417 counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, 418 419 sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, 420 suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district 421 superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's 422 discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate 423 school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations 424 that the school district hires to provide those services. The 425 school district also may use the contributions it receives to 426 pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive 427 training in providing such services to the students of the 428 school district. The school district shall ensure that any 429 charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt 430

from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the431Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the432contributions it receives for any other purpose.433

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 434 receives pursuant to section 4503.874 of the Revised Code to St. 435 Edward high school located in the municipal corporation of 436 Lakewood. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 437 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 438 students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 439 440 pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 441 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 442 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 443 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 444 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 445 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 446 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 447 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 448 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 449 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 450 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 451 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 452 organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 453 subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 454 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 455 456 purpose.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar457receives pursuant to section 4503.877 of the Revised Code to the458Independence local school district. The school district shall459use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs460in providing services to the school district's students that461

assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional 462 well-being of the students. The services provided may include 463 bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 464 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 465 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 466 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school 467 district superintendent or, in the school district 468 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 469 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 470 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 471 services. The school district also may use the contributions it 472 receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 473 district to receive training in providing such services to the 474 students of the school district. The school district shall 475 ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 476 district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 477 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 478 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 479 purpose. 480

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 481 receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 482 American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 483 chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 484 contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 485 programs on a statewide basis. 486

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar487receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the488nationwide children's hospital foundation.489

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar490receives pursuant to section 4503.901 of the Revised Code to the491

Ohio association for pupil transportation, which shall use the492money to support transportation programs, provide training to493school transportation professionals, and support other494initiatives for school transportation safety.495

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 496 receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 497 Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 498 Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 499 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 500 501 students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 502 students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 503 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 504 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 505 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 506 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 507 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 508 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 509 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 510 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 511 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 512 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 513 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 514 organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 515 subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 516 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 517 purpose. 518

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar519receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the520Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school521district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the522

expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 523 district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 524 mental and emotional well-being of the students. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 574 receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 575 Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 576 solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 577 driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 578 boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 579 vocational school districts. 580

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 581 receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the 582 friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money 583 to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free 584 emergency medical first response throughout Israel. 585

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 586 receives pursuant to section 4503.98 of the Revised Code to the 587 Westerville parks foundation to support the programs and 588 activities of the foundation and its mission of pursuing the 589 city of Westerville's vision of becoming "A City Within A Park." 590

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 591 contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 592 the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 593 distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 594 section the investment income the fund earned the previous 595 calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 596 entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 597 received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 598

(A) Any person who has been awarded the Ohio national quard Ohio cross may apply to the registrar of 600 motor vehicles for the registration of any passenger car, 601 noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 602 vehicle the person owns or leases of a class approved by the 603 registrar.
