## A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing to enact Section 12 of Article XV of the	1
Constitution of the State of Ohio to prohibit dues and	2
other fees payable to an employee organization from	3
being deducted from the payroll check of a public	4
employee and to prohibit those dues and fees from	5
being used for political purposes unless authorized by	6
the public employee.	7
Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of	8
Ohio, three-fifths of the members elected to each house	9
concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to the electors	10
of the state, in the manner prescribed by law at the general	11
election to be held on November 3, 2020, a proposal to enact	12
Section 12 of Article XV of the Constitution of the State of	13
Ohio to read as follows:	14
ARTICLE XV	15
Section 12. (A) As used in this section:	16
(1) "Employee organization" means any labor or bona fide	17
organization in which public employees participate and that	18
exists for the purpose, in whole or in part, of dealing with	19

public employers concerning grievances, labor disputes, wages,	20
hours, terms, and other conditions of employment.	21
(2) "Public employee" means any person holding a position	22
by appointment or employment in the service of a public	23
<pre>employer.</pre>	24
(3) "Public employer" means the state or any political	25
subdivision of the state located entirely within the state.	26
(B) No public employer shall deduct dues, initiation fees,	27
fair share fees, or other assessments payable to an employee	28
organization from the payroll check of a public employee.	29
(C) Unless a public employee authorizes an employee	30
organization to do so, no employee organization shall use a	31
public employee's dues, initiation fees, assessments, or fair	32
share fees in support of partisan politics or ideological causes	33
not germane to the work of employee organizations in the realm	34
of collective bargaining.	35
EFFECTIVE DATE	36
If adopted by a majority of the electors voting on this	37
proposal, Section 12 of Article XV of the Constitution of the	38
State of Ohio takes effect immediately.	39
