A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing to amend Section 2 of Article II and to repeal

Sections 8 and 9 of Article V of the Constitution of	2
the State of Ohio to eliminate legislative term	3
limits.	4
Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of	5
Ohio, three-fifths of the members elected to each house	6
concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to the electors	7
of the state, in the manner prescribed by law at the general	8
election to be held on November 7, 2017, a proposal to amend	9
Section 2 of Article II and to repeal Sections 8 and 9 of	10
Article V of the Constitution of Ohio to read as follows:	11
ARTICLE II	12
Section 2. Representatives shall be elected biennially by	13
the electors of the respective house of representatives	14
districts; their term of office shall commence on the first day	15
of January next thereafter and continue two years.	16
Senators shall be elected by the electors of the	17
respective senate districts; their terms of office shall	18
commence on the first day of January next after their election.	19
All terms of senators which commence on the first day of	20

January, 1969 shall be four years, and all terms which commence	21
on the first day of January, 1971 shall be four years.	22
Thereafter, except for the filling of vacancies for unexpired	23
terms, senators shall be elected to and hold office for terms of	24
four years.	25
No person shall hold the office of state senator for a	26
period longer than two successive terms of four years. No person-	27
shall hold the office of state representative for a period-	28
longer than four successive terms of two years. Terms shall be	29
considered successive unless separated by a period of four or-	30
more years. Only terms beginning on or after January 1, 1993	31
shall be considered in determining an individual's eligibility	32
to hold office.	33
In determining the eligibility of an individual to hold an	34
office in accordance with this article, (A) time spent in an-	35
office in fulfillment of a term to which another person was	36
first elected shall not be considered provided that a period of	37
at least four years passed between the time, if any, in which	38
the individual previously held that office, and the time the	39
individual is elected or appointed to fulfill the unexpired	40
term; and (B) a person who is elected to an office in a	41
regularly scheduled general election and resigns prior to the	42
completion of the term for which he or she was elected, shall be	43
considered to have served the full term in that office.	44
EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEAL	45
If adopted by a majority of the electors voting on this	46
proposal, the amendment of Section 2 of Article II takes	47
immediate effect and existing Section 2 of Article II and	48
Sections 8 and 9 of Article V of the Constitution of Ohio are	49
repealed from that effective date.	50
