**A RESOLUTION**

Honoring Deputy Jacob Johnson  
on receiving the Medal of Valor.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 135th 1  
General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to congratulate Deputy Jacob 2  
Johnson on being presented with the Charles "Bud" Meeks Award for 3  
Valor by the National Sheriffs' Association; and 4

WHEREAS, Jacob Johnson is, indeed, deserving of high praise, for 5  
he has combined civic concern and commitment with selfless initiative 6  
to become a dynamic leader in the field of law enforcement. A member 7  
of the Marion County Sheriff's Office, he was on duty on the night of 8  
November 21, 2022, when he and his partner, Deputy Jarrod Kidwell, 9  
were alerted of 911 calls reporting a crash that resulted in a van 10  
going into an icy pond and becoming submerged. Despite the frigid 11  
temperature, they responded ably along with other emergency personnel 12  
by entering the water and extricating the five occupants of the 13  
sinking vehicle. Without a doubt, their quick actions prevented an 14  
even greater tragedy from occurring; and 15

WHEREAS, Fulfilling his myriad duties with the utmost efficiency 16  
and competence, Jacob Johnson has given willingly of his time, energy, 17  
and abilities far beyond what was required or expected, and he is 18  
certainly a hard-working Ohioan. Receiving this prestigious 19  
distinction is a justifiable source of pride and an excellent 20  
reflection not only on him but also on his family, his supervisors, 21  
his department, and the whole of Marion County, and we applaud his 22  
exemplary efforts; and 23

WHEREAS, At a time when many people are content to take a passive 24  
role in life, Jacob Johnson has chosen a vocation through which he has 25  
often risked his own safety to ensure the well-being of his fellow 26

citizens. His enthusiasm and devotion to duty have gained him the 27
