## A RESOLUTION

Observing April 2022 as the Month of the Military Child in Ohio.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 134th 1 General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize the Month of the 2 Military Child in Ohio, April 2022; and 3

WHEREAS, In an effort to increase public knowledge and 4 understanding of the issues surrounding children who have a parent in 5 the military, the month of April was first designated by then U.S. 6 Secretary of Defense Caspar Weinberger as the Month of the Military 7 Child in 1986. The children of U.S. Armed Forces members are, indeed, 8 deserving of profound admiration for their strength, honor, and 9 sacrifices; and 10

WHEREAS, As Americans enjoy the freedom and democracy that 11 service men and women help to perpetuate, we feel the deepest respect 12 for military families in their own right as individuals who have 13 imparted a stalwart sense of patriotic duty and who have accepted the 14 risks of service with dignity and courage. There are those who take 15 for granted our precious rights and privileges, never adequately 16 considering the enormous personal costs so frequently exacted in 17 conjunction with the fulfillment of military obligations. We owe it to 18 military families, especially their children, who may move many times 19 throughout their lives, bear the burden of a parent being in harm's 20 way, and endure long separations from their parent, to remain keenly 21 aware of how dearly our nation has always paid for its liberty and its 22 ideals; and 23

WHEREAS, Childhood is a formative time, and family members,24together with communities, educators, public officials, and faith-25based organizations, play important roles in helping to ensure that26

children grow up in a safe and stable environment, one that provides 27 nurturing love and encouragement. All Ohioans share the responsibility 28 of supporting our youth, and during the month of April, we renew our 29 commitment to children with a parent in the military, offering care 30 and concern as well as understanding and empathy. In addition, we urge 31 all citizens to mark this observance by advocating for those who are 32 serving our country and their families; therefore be it 33

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the House of Representatives of 34 the 134th General Assembly of Ohio, in adopting this Resolution, 35 acknowledge the Month of the Military Child in Ohio, April 2022, and 36 urge all citizens to participate in appropriate programs and 37 activities associated with it; and be it further 38
