A RESOLUTION

In memory of Lieutenant Philip M. Wigal.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 134th 1
General Assembly of Ohio have learned, with deepest regret, of the 2
passing of Lieutenant Philip M. Wigal and pay tribute to his memory; 3

WHEREAS, Philip Wigal will be remembered fondly by all those who 5
knew and loved him, and his absence will leave an irreparable void in 6
our society. A member of the Town and Country Fire District since 7
2006, he was hired as a full-time firefighter/emergency medical 8
technician in 2011 and went on to become an emergency medical services 9
instructor and fire inspector as well as president of the Town and 10
Country Fire Association. In addition, he was a part-time firefighter 11
with the Lodi and Canaan Fire Departments, and he built a notable 12
reputation characterized by courage and composure even under the most 13
trying of circumstances; and 14

to those who have died in the line of duty, and this is an ideal time 16
to recall, with a blend of sorrow and profound appreciation, the 17
