A RESOLUTION

Honoring The University of Akron on its One Hundred
Fiftieth Anniversary.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 1
133rd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to congratulate The 2
University of Akron on the auspicious occasion of its 3
Sesquicentennial, celebrated October 10, 2020; and 4

WHEREAS, Throughout the past one hundred fifty years, The 5
University of Akron has played a valuable role in preparing 6
students to meet the challenges of the future and improving the 7
well-being of our state, regional, national, and global 8
communities. Established in 1870 by the Ohio Universalist 9
Convention, the institution began operating as Buchtel College 10
before becoming a nondenominational, private liberal arts college 11
in 1907 and being renamed in 1913. Over the past century and a 12
half, the university has expanded to include a diverse curriculum 13
and an enrollment of approximately 19,200 students across four 14
campuses as well as online, and despite innumerable changes over 15
the years, UA remains committed to the principles upon which it 16
