## **AN ACT**

To enact section 5.078 of the Revised Code to designate the Dunkleosteus terrelli as the official state fossil fish.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

**Section 1.** That section 5.078 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

<u>Sec. 5.078. Dunkleosteus terrelli</u>, a species of extinct arthrodire placoderm fish that lived in the seas that covered parts of Ohio during the Late Devonian period, about three hundred fifty-nine to three hundred eighty-two million years ago, is hereby adopted as the official fossil fish of the state.
