A BILL

To enact section 5534.70 of the Revised Code to
designate a portion of State Route 123 within
Warren County as the "Neil Armstrong Memorial
Way."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.70 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

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Sec. 5534.70. The following portions of state route number
one hundred twenty-three within Warren county only shall be
known as the "Neil Armstrong Memorial Way":

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(A) Commencing at the intersection of that state route and
state route number one hundred twenty-two on the east side of
the community of Red Lion and proceeding in a southerly
direction to the intersection of state route one hundred twenty-
three and Hart road within the municipal corporation of Lebanon;

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(B) Within the municipal corporation of Lebanon, the
portion of state route one hundred twenty-three known as the

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state route one hundred twenty-three bypass, commencing at the 17
intersection of the bypass and Hart road and proceeding in a 18
southerly direction to the intersection of the bypass and state 19
route number sixty-three. 20

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 21
along those portions of the highway indicating their name. 22
