(B) Use <u>A</u> covered entity shall not use or disclose	26
protected health information in a manner that is not consistent	27
with 45 C.F.R. 164.502 and, to the extent section 4731.74 of the	28
Revised Code is more stringent than 45 C.F.R. 164.502, section	29
4731.74 of the Revised Code.	30
Sec. 4731.74. (A) As used in this section, "physician"	31
means an individual authorized under this chapter to practice	32
medicine and surgery, osteopathic medicine and surgery, or	33
podiatric medicine and surgery.	34
(B) Except as provided in division (C) of this section, a	35
physician or physician's delegate shall not submit any portion	36
of a patient's medical record to an electronic database created	37
or maintained by a government entity or person, other than the	38
physician, unless any of the following individuals, as	39
applicable, signs an authorization that is valid under 45 C.F.R.	40
164.508 and, if applicable, 42 C.F.R. part 2:	41
(1) In the case of a patient who is an adult, the patient,	42
the patient's guardian, or an authorized person as defined in	43
section 3701.74 of the Revised Code;	44
(2) In the case of a patient who is a minor, the patient's	45

extent that the disclosure of protected health information, as	49

Sec. 4731.78. (A) As used in this section:	78
(1) "Firearm" has the same meaning as in section 2923.11	79
of the Revised Code.	80
(2) "Physician" means an individual authorized under this	81
chapter to practice medicine and surgery, osteopathic medicine	82
and surgery, or podiatric medicine and surgery.	83
(B) A physician shall not ask a patient or prospective	84
patient, or that person's representative, whether the patient or	85
prospective patient, or any individual residing in the patient's	86
or prospective patient's place of residence, owns or possesses a	87
firearm or any other question related to the ownership or	88
possession of a firearm.	89
Section 2. That existing section 3798.04 of the Revised	90
Code is hereby repealed.	91
