# A BILL

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section	1
4503.578 of the Revised Code to create the "Keep	2
Ohio Beautiful" license plate.	3

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4
4503.578 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	8
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to	9
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495,	10
4503.496, 4503.497, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501,	11
4503.502, 4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.514, 4503.521, 4503.522,	12

4503.722, 4503.73, 4503.732, 4503.733, 4503.74, 4503.75, 19 4503.751, 4503.752, 4503.763, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.87, 20 4503.871, 4503.874, 4503.877, 4503.89, 4503.90, 4503.901, 21 4503.902, 4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, 4503.97, and 22 4503.98 of the Revised Code. 23 (B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 24 registrar collects in the fund as follows: 25 The registrar shall pay the contributions received 26 pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 27 cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 28 programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 29 cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 30 quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 31 the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 32 other abortion-related activities. 33 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 34 receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 35 organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 36 deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 37

organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 38 the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 39 manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 40 other money in that fund. 41

The registrar shall pay the contributions received42pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism43society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs44and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.45

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar46receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the47

national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services directly to their clients.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with pancreatic cancer and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for its research and other programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar68receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to69special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions70for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.71

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar72receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the73children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the74contributions for its research and other programs.75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 77 future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 78 contributions into its general account to be used for 79 educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 80 America foundation. 81

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 87 pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 88 cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 89 scholarships and other educational activities. 90

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those contributions for scholarships for students who are members of that organization.

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 96 receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 97 university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 98 collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 99 section. A university or college that receives contributions 100 from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 101 scholarship fund. 102

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar103receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the104university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of105

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awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend106the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it107receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program.108The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with the109university of Notre Dame to effectuate the distribution of such110funds as provided in this section.111

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar112receives pursuant to section 4503.521 of the Revised Code to the113Ohio bicycle federation to assist that organization in paying114for the educational programs it sponsors in support of Ohio115cyclists of all ages.116

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 117 receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 118 "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 119 incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 120 of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 121 expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 122 educational, and cultural events at the monument. 123

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 124 receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 125 fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 126 the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 127 lighthouses of fairport harbor. 128

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar129receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the130Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the131contributions only to promote and support the football team of132Washington high school of the Massillon city school district.133

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 134

receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 135 United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 136 four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 137 district shall use the money it receives under this section to 138 pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 139 sponsors within this state. 140

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 141 receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 142 Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 143 international, which shall use the money it receives under this 144 section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 145 activities. 146

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the provision of services to children, young adults, and families in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 154 receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 155 Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 156 receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 157 to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 158 to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 159 their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 160 research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 161 the improvement of patient outcomes. 162

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar163receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the164

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thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 165 organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 166 organization in paying for the charitable activities and 167 programs it sponsors in support of United States military 168 personnel, veterans, and their families. 169

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 170 receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 171 disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 172 programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 173 families. 174

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 175 receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 176 pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 177 into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 178 be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 179 hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 180 of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 181 destination. 182

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 183 the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state.

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 188 contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 189 4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 190 source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 191 designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 192 Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 193 section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 194

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cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 195 veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 196 pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 197 maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 198

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 199 receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 200 rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 201

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 202 receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 203 Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 204 corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 205 the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 206 members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 207 charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 208 provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 209 Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 210 for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 211 promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 212 incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 213 under this section. 214

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 215 receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 216 Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 217 the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 220 receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 221 western reserve historical society, which shall use the 222 contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 223

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar224receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the225Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple226negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the227contributions for charitable and educational purposes.228

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 229 receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 230 state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 231 deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 232 233 establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 234 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 235 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 236 managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 237 Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 238 registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 239 such payments are to be made. 240

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning river watershed.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 250 receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 251 conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 252 the money in support of the park. 253

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 254 receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 255 Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 256 contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 257 information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 258 local beekeeping programs. 259

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 260 receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 261 national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 262 contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 263 legends to inspire future leaders. 264

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.578 of the Revised Code to keep Ohio beautiful, which shall use the contributions towards its mission of empowering Ohio communities to take greater responsibility for improving the local environment through litter prevention, beautification, community greening, waste reduction, and recycling.

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 272 pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 273 contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 274 applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 275 professional sports team located in the county of that sports 276 commission and that is participating in the license plate 277 program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 278 of the county of residence of an applicant. 279

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each280contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of281the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates282that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is283

participating in the license plate program pursuant to division 284 (G) of that section. 285 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 286 receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to 287 pollinator partnership's monarch wings across Ohio program, 288 which shall use the contributions for the protection and 289 preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in 290 Ohio and for educational programs. 291 292 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 293 Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 294 shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 295 throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 296 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 297 receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 298 great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 299 America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 300

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar303receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the304Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council305shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner306throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.307

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 308 receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 309 Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 310 which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 311

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 312

receives pursuant to section 4503.702 of the Revised Code to the 313 Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order 314 of the Elks of the World, which shall use the funds for 315 charitable purposes. 316

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar317receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the318fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall319deposit the fees into its general account to be used for320purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.321

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 322 receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 323 fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 324 deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 325 used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 326 enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 327 methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 328

The registrar shall pay the contributions received329pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio330concerns of police survivors, which shall use those331contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate332to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed333in the line of duty.334

The registrar shall pay the contributions received335pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater336Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those337contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in338the line of duty and support its charitable purposes.339

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 340 receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 341

fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions342to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their343families.344

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 345 receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 346 organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 347 association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 348 Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 349 shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 350 351 administering a program to secure the proper representation in the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 352 children, and for the training and supervision of persons 353 354 participating in that program.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 355 receives pursuant to section 4503.722 of the Revised Code to the 356 Down Syndrome Association of Central Ohio, which shall use the 357 contributions for advocacy purposes throughout the state. 358

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar359receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to360Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the361contributions into its general account to be used for purposes362of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated.363

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 364 receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 365 Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 366 commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 367 Cleveland, Ohio. 368

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar369receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to the370

Ohio chapter of the juvenile diabetes research foundation in371whose geographic territory the person who paid the contribution372resides.373

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 374 receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 375 Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 376 moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 377 4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 378 agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 379

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 380 receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 381 rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 382 Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 383 used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 384 rotary foundation. 385

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 386 receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 387 Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 388 contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 389 under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 390

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 391 receives pursuant to section 4503.752 of the Revised Code to 392 buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the 393 contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs. 394

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 395 receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 396 Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 397 maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 398 connection. 399 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 400 receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 401 Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 402 research projects. 403

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 404 receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 405 Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 406 contributions solely to promote and support the historical 407 preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 408 state. 409

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar410receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the411Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those412contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth413baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City.414

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 415 receives pursuant to section 4503.871 of the Revised Code to the 416 Solon city school district. The school district shall use the 417 contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in 418 providing services to the school district's students that assist 419 in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being 420 of the students. The services provided may include bereavement 421 counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, 422 423 sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, 424 suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district 425 superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's 426 discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate 427 school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations 428 that the school district hires to provide those services. The 429

school district also may use the contributions it receives to 430 pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive 431 training in providing such services to the students of the 432 school district. The school district shall ensure that any 433 charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt 434 from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the 435 Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the 436 contributions it receives for any other purpose. 437

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 438 receives pursuant to section 4503.874 of the Revised Code to St. 439 Edward high school located in the municipal corporation of 440 Lakewood. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 441 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 442 students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 443 pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 444 students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 445 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 446 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 447 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 448 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 449 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 450 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 451 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 452 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 453 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 454 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 455 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 456 organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 457 subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 458 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 459 460 purpose.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 461 receives pursuant to section 4503.877 of the Revised Code to the 462 Independence local school district. The school district shall 463 use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs 464 in providing services to the school district's students that 465 assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional 466 well-being of the students. The services provided may include 467 bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 468 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 469 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 470 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school 471 district superintendent or, in the school district 472 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 473 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 474 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 475 services. The school district also may use the contributions it 476 receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 477 district to receive training in providing such services to the 478 students of the school district. The school district shall 479 ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 480 district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 481 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 482 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 483 purpose. 484

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 485 receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 486 American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 487 chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 488 contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 489 programs on a statewide basis. 490

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the nationwide children's hospital foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 494 receives pursuant to section 4503.901 of the Revised Code to the 495 Ohio association for pupil transportation, which shall use the 496 money to support transportation programs, provide training to 497 school transportation professionals, and support other 498 initiatives for school transportation safety. 499

500 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 501 Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 502 Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 503 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 504 students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 505 pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 506 students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 507 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 508 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 509 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 510 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 511 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 512 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 513 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 514 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 515 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 516 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 517 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 518 organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 519 subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 520 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 521 522 purpose.

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 523 receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the 524 Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school 525 district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 526 expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 527 district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 528 529 mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 530 defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 531 counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 532 violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 533 The school district superintendent or, in the school district 534 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 535 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 536 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 537 services. The school district also may use the contributions it 538 receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 539 district to receive training in providing such services to the 540 students of the school district. The school district shall 541 ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 542 district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 543 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 544 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 545 purpose. 546

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 547 receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the 548 Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school 549 district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 550 expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 551 district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 552 mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 553

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 578 receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 579 Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 580 solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 581 driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 582 boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 583 vocational school districts. 584

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 585 receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the 586 friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money 587 to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free 588 emergency medical first response throughout Israel. 589

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 590 receives pursuant to section 4503.98 of the Revised Code to the 591 Westerville parks foundation to support the programs and 592 activities of the foundation and its mission of pursuing the 593 city of Westerville's vision of becoming "A City Within A Park." 594

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 595 contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 596 the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 597 distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 598 section the investment income the fund earned the previous 599 calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 600 entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 601 received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 602

Sec. 4503.578. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger603car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other604vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles605may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle606and issuance of "Keep Ohio Beautiful" license plates.607

The application may be combined with a request for a608special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42609of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application610and compliance by the applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of611this section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the612appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "Keep Ohio613Beautiful" license plates and a validation sticker, or a614
