## A BILL

To enact section 4508.041 of the Revised Code to	1
authorize an eligible adult to act in lieu of a	2
driver training instructor while using an	3
authorized electronic device or application.	4

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4508.041 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4508.041. (A) As used in this section, "eligible	7
adult" has the same meaning as in section 4507.21 of the Revised	8
Code.	9
(B) Notwithstanding section 4508.04 of the Revised Code,	10
an eligible adult may act in lieu of a driver training	11
instructor for the eight hours of actual behind-the-wheel	12
instruction required to complete a student's driver education	13
course, provided all of the following apply:	14
(1) The eligible adult is assisted by an electronic device	15
or application that is programmed to offer mobile and in-vehicle	16
instruction to the student driver.	17
(2) The eligible adult is in the vehicle with the student	18

driver at all times during the active instruction provided by 19 the electronic device or application. 20 (3) The student driver has completed the twenty-four hours 21 of classroom instruction. 22 23 (4) The electronic device or application is programmed to comply with the department of public safety's driver training 24 curriculum and has been approved by the director of public 25 safety to be used in lieu of a driver training instructor for 26 behind-the-wheel instruction. The director shall not 27 unreasonably withhold approval of an electronic device or 28 application if that device meets the requirements set forth in 29 rules adopted under division (D)(1) of this section. 30 (C) An eligible adult may use an electronic device or 31 application that is programmed to offer mobile and in-vehicle 32 instruction to the student driver to assist in supervising the 33 fifty hours of actual driving experience required by division 34 (B) (2) of section 4507.21 of the Revised Code. 35 (D) (1) The director shall adopt rules in accordance with 36 Chapter 119. of the Revised Code establishing any procedures and 37 requirements necessary to implement this section. 38 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of section 121.95 of the 39 Revised Code to the contrary, a regulatory restriction contained 40 in a rule adopted under this section is not subject to sections 41 121.95 to 121.953 of the Revised Code. 42 (E) An eligible adult acting in lieu of a driver training 43 instructor in accordance with this section and the rules adopted 44 by the director is exempt from the driver training instructor 45

licensure requirements of this chapter.
