A BILL

To make supplemental appropriations in order to 1
provide political subdivisions with funding for 2
road maintenance repairs. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. All items in this section are hereby 4
appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 5
treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 6
appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 7
for fiscal year 2018 and those in the second column are for 8
fiscal year 2019. The appropriations made in this act are in 9
addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2018-FY 10
2019 biennium. 11

from the foregoing appropriation item shall be distributed in			24
the same manner and in the same proportions to political			25

Sub. H.B. 26 of the 132nd General Assembly. The foregoing			27
appropriation item shall supplement, not supplant, existing			28
revenue received by political subdivisions for transportation			29
maintenance and construction purposes.			30
Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on			31
March 1, 2018, or as soon as possible thereafter, the Director			32
of Budget and Management shall transfer \$30,000,000 cash from			33
the Budget Stabilization Fund to the Gasoline Excise Tax Fund			34
(Fund 7060).			35
Section 2. Within the limits set forth in this act, the			36
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts			37
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation			38
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in			39
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures			40
from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for			41
as though made in Am. Sub. H.B. 49 of the 132nd General			42
