any act to affirm, continue, or reinstate membership in or	10
affiliation with any student or other organization that causes	11
or creates a substantial risk of causing mental or physical harm	12
to any person.	13
(B)(1) No person shall recklessly participate in the hazing of another.	14 15
(2) No administrator, employee, or faculty member of any	16
primary, secondary, or post-secondary school or of any other	17
educational institution public or private shall recklessly	1.8
