(135th General Assembly) (Amended Senate Bill Number 34)

AN ACT

To amend section 5.27 and to enact section 5.271 of the Revised Code to designate April as "Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month" and July as "Sarcoma Awareness Month" and to name certain provisions of the act as Hank's Law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That section 5.27 be amended and section 5.271 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.27. The month of <u>September April</u> is designated as "Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month."

Sec. 5.271. The month of July is designated as "Sarcoma Awareness Month" to raise awareness of sarcoma, a type of cancer that affects humans and canines.

SECTION 2. That existing section 5.27 of the Revised Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Section 5.271 of the Revised Code, as enacted by this act, shall be known as Hank's Law.
