A BILL

То	establish a committee, in recognition of the	1

	amend Section 297.10 of Am. Sub. H.B. 49 of the	5

	to make an appropriation.	7

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A)(1) There is hereby established a committee,	8
in recognition of the 400th anniversary of African Americans in	9
Ohio and the United States, to study the progress and challenges	10
of African Americans in Ohio. The committee shall review various	11
reports on African Americans in Ohio, including the Report of	12
the Ohio Commission on Racial Fairness, the Governor's Task	13
Force Report on Black and Minority Health, and any reports	14
prepared by public or private research institutions in Ohio that	15
the committee determines are relevant.	16
(2) After reviewing the reports specified under division	17
(A) (1) of this section, the committee shall prepare an initial	18

report of all of the following:	19
(a) The progress or lack of progress of African Americans	20
in Ohio with respect to housing, transportation, health,	21
education, employment, environment, business development, and	22
any other policy area that the committee chooses to consider;	23
(b) The contributions and achievements by African	24
Americans in Ohio;	25
(c) Recommendations for addressing the challenges	26
identified under division (A)(2) of this section for African	27
Americans in Ohio.	28
Not later than December 31, 2019, the initial report shall	29
be submitted to the General Assembly in accordance with section	30
101.68 of the Revised Code and to the news media of Ohio. The	31
committee shall include with the report an announcement of the	32
schedule of hearings it will hold on the report in accordance	33
with division (A)(3) of this section.	34
(3) Not earlier than three months after submitting its	35
initial report under division (A)(2) of this section, the	36
committee shall reconvene for the purpose of holding hearings in	37
various parts of the state regarding its initial report. The	38
committee shall determine how many hearings to hold, the	39
schedule for these hearings, and the locations in which these	40
hearings will be held. These hearings shall be held over a	41
period of time that does not exceed four months.	42
The committee shall announce the schedule of the hearings	43
at the time it releases its initial report under division (A)(2)	44
of this section.	45
(4) Following the completion of the hearings held by the	46
committee under division (A)(3) of this section, the committee	47

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shall revise its initial report based on the information	48
gathered during the hearings. Not later than October 31, 2020,	49
the committee shall submit its final report to the General	50
Assembly in accordance with section 101.68 of the Revised Code	51
and to the news media of Ohio. Upon submission of the final	52
report under division (A)(4) of this section, the committee	53
shall be abolished.	54
(B)(1) The committee shall consist of ten members	55
appointed by the Governor, five members appointed by the	56
President of the Senate, five members appointed by the Minority	57
Leader of the Senate, five members appointed by the Speaker of	58
the House of Representatives, and five members appointed by the	59
Minority Leader of the House of Representatives. The appointed	60
members shall be representatives of all of the following:	61
(a) The Ohio History Connection;	62
(b) The National Museum of Afro-American History and	63
Culture;	64
(c) Public and private research institutions in Ohio,	65
including the John Glenn College of Public Affairs at the Ohio	66
State University, the Kirwan Institution for the Study of Race	67
and Ethnicity at the Ohio State University, Case Western Reserve	68
University, Cleveland State University, and the Health Policy	69
Institute of Ohio.	70
(2) Within thirty days after the effective date of this	71
section, the committee shall hold its first meeting and select a	72
chairperson and vice-chairperson.	73
(3) The committee may, in its discretion, establish	74
subcommittees and designate members of the committee to serve on	75
those subcommittees. Each subcommittee may, in its discretion,	76

Historical Grants, \$100,000 in each fiscal year shall be used	138
for the Cincinnati Museum Center, \$100,000 in each fiscal year	139
shall be used for the Western Reserve Historical Society,	140
\$100,000 in each fiscal year shall be used for the Cleveland	141
Museum of Natural History, and \$100,000 in each fiscal year	142
shall be used for the Cleveland Institute of Art.	143

Of the foregoing appropriation item 360509, Outreach and	145
Partnership, \$70,000 in each fiscal year shall be distributed to	146
the Ohio World War I Centennial Working Group.	147
Of the foregoing appropriation item 360509, Outreach and	148
Partnership, up to \$140,000 in fiscal year 2019 shall be used to	149
pay the expenses of the committee to study the progress and	150
