#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5122.04 of the Revised Code be	3
amended to read as follows:	4
Sec. 5122.04. (A) Upon the request of a minor fourteen	5
years of age or older, a mental health professional may provide	6
outpatient mental health services, excluding the use of	7
medication, without the consent or knowledge of the minor's	8
parent or guardian. Except as otherwise provided in this	9
section, the minor's parent or guardian shall not be informed of	10
the services without the minor's consent unless the mental	11
health professional treating the minor determines that there is	12
a compelling need for disclosure based on a substantial	13
probability of harm to the minor or to other persons, and if the	14
minor is notified of the mental health professional's intent to	15
inform the minor's parent, or guardian.	16
(B) Services provided to a minor pursuant to this section	17
shall be limited to not more than six sessions or thirty days of	18

services whichever occurs sooner. After the sixth session or	19
thirty days of services the mental health professional shall	20
terminate the services or, with the consent of the minor, notify	21
the parent, or guardian, to obtain consent to provide further	22
outpatient services.	23
(C) The minor's parent or guardian shall not be liable for	24
the costs of services which are received by a minor under	25
division (A).	26
(D) Nothing in this section relieves a mental health	27
professional from the obligations of section 2151.421 of the	28
Revised Code.	29
(E) As used in this section, "mental health professional"	30
has the same meaning as in section $\frac{340.02}{2305.51}$ of the Revised	31
Code.	32
Section 2. That existing section 5122.04 of the Revised	33
Code is hereby repealed.	34
