Section 1. All items in this section are hereby 5 appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 6 7 treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 8 9 for fiscal year 2022 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2023. The appropriations made in this act are in 10 addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2022-FY 11 2023 biennium. 12
