In memory of Specialist Joseph P. Collette.

Collette in their bereavement; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Collette left an indelible impression on the
lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a spirited
individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around him.
Commencing his tenure with the U.S. Army in 2010, he was the
recipient of the Excellence in Competition Rifleman Badge, two
Army Good Conduct medals, four Army Achievement medals, and a
Purple Heart, and he was serving as a member of the 242nd Ordnance
Battalion, 71st Explosive Ordnance Disposal Group in Afghanistan
when he gave his life in the line of duty. A 2007 graduate of
Lancaster High School, he embodied a combination of knowledge and
commitment that made him a truly valuable part of our country's
armed forces, and we take this opportunity to remember his
exceptional record of service, a legacy that will surely live on;
