To urge the Congress of the United States to enact	1

WHEREAS, On January 27, 2017, the President of the United8States issued an executive order generally prohibiting persons9from Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, and Yemen from10entering the United States for a period of 90 days; suspending11the United States Refugee Admissions program for a period of 12012days; and indefinitely prohibiting Syrian nationals from13entering the United States as refugees; and14

WHEREAS, The executive order is blatantly discriminatory and is repugnant to the principles on which our nation was founded; and

WHEREAS, No legitimate national security concern exists to18justify banning refugees from entering the United States; and19

WHEREAS, Given the severity of the consequences of the

executive order, the President of the United States should not	21
be able to take such actions unilaterally; now therefore be it	22
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Senate of the State	23
of Ohio, urge the Congress of the United States immediately to	24
enact legislation rescinding the executive order and limiting	25
the authority of the President of the United States to prohibit	26
classes of persons from entering the United States under the	27
