WHEREAS, Although there are no words to ease the sorrow now felt, surely there is solace in the remembrance of having known such an outstanding individual. A 2004 graduate of Ashland High School, where he excelled in golf and participated in swimming and tennis, and a 2008 graduate of Xavier University, where he was active with the Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Michael Runyan was a platoon leader with the 2nd Stryker Brigade Combat Team of the 25th Infantry Division of the U.S. Army, and he was serving in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom when he was killed in the line of duty. His valiant efforts were truly admirable, and his absence will be keenly felt; and
